**SECURITY ALERT – Data Breach linked to Major Retail Merchant (Home Depot)**

Late yesterday evening, Home Depot issued a [news release confirming they have experienced a data breach](#). Rumors of a breach at Home Depot have been circulating since late last week.

Home Depot's press release states that the breach goes back to April 2014. The release does not clarify whether every account used at Home Depot since April was impacted, nor does their release give information about precisely what card information may have been compromised, although they have indicated that no debit PIN info was impacted.

At this time, Martin Federal Credit Union has not received any specific information from Visa or MasterCard regarding affected accounts.

To ensure prompt notification of possible fraudulent activity on your account, we ask that you verify and update your contact information with us. Also, we suggest you monitor your accounts ongoing and if you see any unusual activity, contact us immediately at 407-857-6328 x4000. To aid in close monitoring of your accounts we offer text and email alerts that you can set up in Online Banking.
